Farmington Baseball is pleased to announce the 4th **Annual Invitational** for Shetland, Mustang, Bronco and Pony All-Star teams. Teams not PONY affiliated are also welcome. This will be a great opportunity for your league teams to play prior to the district games!

This Invitational will be a pool play tournament with each team playing 4 qualifying games. Top 2 seeds from each pool or top 4 seeds in one pool move into a single elimination bracket with the highest seeded teams playing the lowest seeded teams. Each team is guaranteed 4 games. PONY tournament rules apply however teams can bat entire lineup.

Schedules will be available online. The single elimination bracket will begin on Tuesday, June 28th.

Individual Trophies will be awarded to first and second place teams.

NEW EVENT: "THE SHOWCASE" Skills Competition and Dinner will be held on June 22nd at 7p.m. Players can compete in the home run derby, home to plate to second throw down, outfield relay, around the horn, fastest player. ALL age groups, including Pinto teams can participate! Dinner cost per person \$5 (2 slices pizza and pop). Players in jerseys will receive slice of pizza and pop for free.

New Events for Farmington Invitational

Players will be selected by the coach to participate in the following events:

“Fastest Player” Player will start at or behind home plate and run to first, second, third, and back home. Timing will start when runner passes home plate and end when runner crosses home. Three timers will mark the time and an average will be calculated. Shetland Players will run to first only. Adults may participate for \$2.

“Around the Horn” Player will be stationed at home, first, second, and third. A ball will be placed behind home plate. Player at home will throw to third, player at third will throw to second, player at second will throw to first, player at first will throw to home. Players must catch ball, touch the base with their foot before throwing to next base. Timing will start when timers say “go”. Adult team may enter for \$5.

“Throw Down” Player will be stationed at pitcher, catcher, and second base. Pitcher will throw pitch, catcher will throw down to second, second base player must catch ball and touch base with mitt. Timing will start when pitcher begins his delivery home. Adult team may enter for \$5.

“Outfield Relay” Player will be stationed in outfield near center field fence. Player will be stationed at shortstop. Player will be stationed at home. Ball will be placed against the fence. Player will pick up ball, throw to cutoff at shortstop, cutoff will throw home. Catcher must catch ball and tag home base with mitt. Timing will start when timers say “go”. Adult team may enter for \$5.

“Home Run Derby” Batter will get 10 swings at pitches from a pitching machine. Most home runs will be counted. Any ball that is “robbed” by a fielder from going over the fence will be counted as a home run. Mustang players may be judged on the furthest hit ball. Shetland players will have a coach pitch and the player will have 5 swings and be judged on furthest hit. Adults may enter the home run derby for \$1 per swing. All adult scoring will be in the “Adult Division” and awards will be not be given simply to prevent embarrassing the adult participants 😊
